

GUIDE: INSTALLING THE OMNICOMM CONFIGURATOR APP ON ANDROID FROM AN APK FILE (WITHOUT GOOGLE PLAY)

What is an APK

APK (Android Package) is the installer file for Android apps.

To install the Omnicomm Configurator application directly from an APK file on your Android smartphone, please follow the instructions below.

Step 1. Download the Omnicomm Configurator APK File

1. Open your phone's browser and go to:
omnicomm-world.com/documents/apk-omnicomm-configurator-1-0-15/
2. Download the OmnicommConfigurator.apk file — it will be saved to your phone's "Downloads" folder.

⚠ Only download Omnicomm Configurator from the official omnicomm-world.com website. A file from an unverified source may contain malicious code.

Step 2. Allow Installation of Apps from Unknown Sources

Starting with **Android 8.0 (Oreo)**, this permission is no longer granted globally for the entire device — it's granted per app, for whichever app you use to install the APK (e.g., your browser). The instructions below apply to Android 8.0 and all newer versions, including Android 12–15.

1. Open the downloaded OmnicommConfigurator.apk file (via your file manager or the download-complete notification).
2. The system will show a warning: *"Your phone is not allowed to install unknown apps from this source."*
3. Tap **Settings** in that same dialog.
4. Turn on the **Allow from this source** toggle.
5. Tap the back button — you'll automatically return to the APK installation screen.

Step 3. Install Omnicomm Configurator

1. Open your file manager (or the "Downloads" app) and locate the downloaded OmnicommConfigurator.apk file.
2. Tap the file.
3. A screen will appear showing information about the app and the permissions it requests. Verify that the app name shown is **Omnicomm Configurator**.
4. Tap **Install**.
5. Wait for the installation to finish — you'll see an "App installed" message.
6. Tap **Open** to launch Omnicomm Configurator immediately, or **Done** to exit the installer.
